Dorsey C. Miller, Jr. was born in Ocala, Florida, on January 7, 1943 to Dorsey C. and Eudora Miller. Dorsey attended the public schools of Montclair New Jersey, Brooklyn New York and Ocala, Florida.

Dr. Miller has devoted a great deal of his professional and personal life to serving the community through his work with civic organizations. He has received more than 400 awards in recognition of his commitment to uplifting humanity. He received his Bachelor's degree from Morehouse College in Atlanta (1965), his Master's degree from the University of Florida in Gainesville (1971) and his Doctor of Education degree from Florida Atlantic University in Boca Raton (1980).

Dr. Miller is a former Executive Director of Diversity & Equal Educational Opportunities, for the School Board of Broward County and is President of D.C. Miller and Associates, Inc.

Dr. Miller served as the 35th Grand Basileus (National President) of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. He is affiliated with numerous civic and community organizations. He served on the Trustee Board of Mr. Olive Baptist Church for 14 years and is listed in *Who's Who in Black America*, *Who's Who Among Outstanding Americans*, and *Ebony Magazine's* 100 Most Influential Blacks in America. In December 2000, he was appointed by Governor Jeb Bush as a commissioner on the North Broward Hospital District's (Broward Health) Board of Commissioners and was a Presidential Elector for the 2000 election. Additionally, Dr. Miller served as the Statewide Coordinator for African Americans for Governor Jeb Bush's re-election campaign in 2002, and also served as Statewide Co-Chair for the re-election of President George W. Bush.

Dr. Miller is a former member of the Broward County Human Rights Board, Board of Directors of the Kiwanis Club of Central Broward, Board of Directors of the American Cancer Society, Broward Community College Board of Trustees, Board of Directors of the Urban League of Broward County, Broward County YMCA Board of Directors, Board of Governors of the Greater Ft. Lauderdale Chamber of Commerce, and Board of Supervisors for the South Florida Sports and Entertainment District (Blockbuster Park).

Dr. Miller and his wife Betty (a retired teacher) have two sons: Dr. Eric Todd Miller, Sr., principal, (LaVonda) and Dorsey C. Miller III, attorney, (Alonna). The Millers have five grandchildren Eric Jr., Dorsey IV, India, Christopher, and Andrew.
